
MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

CERAMIC / PORCELAIN TILE & GROUT FLOORS PENETRATING SEALER

Neutral cleaners are what are necessary & safe to effectively clean ceramic and porcelain tile floors. We recommend buying a quality commercial neutral concentrated cleaner.

1. Always sweep or vacuum your entire floor thoroughly to remove all loose dirt and dust before wet cleaning outlined in the following instructions.
2. Dilute 100ml Ph. Neutral concentrate with 4 Litres warm water, or as directed on the label.
3. Apply diluted cleaner to the floor generously with a mop, allow to stand on floor for 3-4 minutes. This will allow cleaner to emulsify and loosen any dirt on your floor.
4. Using a grout brush, agitate the grout channels as needed.
5. Use original mop & cleaning solution to pick up soiled water
6. Allow to stand for 2-3 minutes.
7. Using fresh hot mop water, a final mopping will ensure the removal of any residual soils on the floor surface.

As time passes, should your floor begin to look uneven after using the above mopping process, it may be necessary to use a higher concentration of your cleaning solution

Mix a solution 10 parts water & 1-part cleaner concentrate

Follow steps 3-7

Repeat step 7, as you have used a much higher concentration for deep cleaning & will need to ensure the removal of all soils & cleaning solution from the floor.

Remember to change your rinse water regularly.

It may be necessary for occasional professional cleaning where commercial tools will take the cleaning process to the next level.
